

RECIPE: Beer Glaze

For internal use on wood, furniture, stairway, etc.

Dissolve 100 g pigment in approx. 1 litre "flat" beer
("flat" beer is beer without foam, e.g. dripping from the tap).

Beer is the most inexpensive binder. It has been used for painting for a long time.

The paint "smells" like beer only as long as it is still wet.

Beer Paint is suitable as a glaze on oil paint. Beer Paint can be applied onto a fresh oil paint layer.
The oil paint should be lighter than the Beer Paint, e.g:

Oil Paint:	Sienna in linseed oil
Beer Paint:	Burnt Sienna in beer

This Beer Glaze is water-insoluble after drying.

This recipe will make enough Beer Paint for about 20 square meters.

Pigments for Beer Paint:

Pigments which can easily be dispersed in beer, e.g. earth colours, and which are lightfast.
